

INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE (IB)

This document indicates how transfer credit is awarded for International Baccalaureate (IB) studies. Please note that the following rules and regulations only apply to students admitted to a degree program and who are registered in the **Faculty of Arts and Science** – **St. George campus** during the **2018/19** academic year.

1	Transfer credit is awarded for Higher Level (HL) exams where a final grade of at least 5 is achieved. No transfer credit is awarded for Standard Level (SL) exams. Students admitted to the Commerce stream are eligible for a maximum of 3.0 credits in transfer.
2	In order to receive credit, final results must reach Enrolment Services by no later than July 13, 2018 . Click here for more information on how to arrange to have the IBO release your results to the University of Toronto. Results issued by your school are not acceptable.

3	If you have taken more than one exam in the same discipline, only 1.0 full credit will be given as students are not permitted to apply more than one first year credit in the same discipline towards their degree. For example, if you have taken History of Africa and History of the Americas, you will receive one HIS credit only.
4	If you wish to decline or forfeit the transfer credits awarded to you, you must consult your College Registrar's Office between April 15 and May 31, 2019 . The option to forfeit is only available to students who have not attended another post-secondary institution. Once forfeited, transfer credits cannot be reinstated.
5	If you choose to forfeit but you were given two half credits, you will forfeit both half credits.
6	More information and advice on the use of transfer credits is available on the Faculty of Arts and Science website .

TERMS DEFINED

Breadth Requirements: Courses in the Faculty of Arts and Science are classified into five Breadth categories by subject content (note that some courses are not designated and do not count toward this requirement).

1. Creative and Cultural Representations (CCR)
2. Thought, Belief, and Behaviour (TBB)
3. Society and Its Institutions (SII)
4. Living Things and Their Environment (LTE)
5. The Physical and Mathematical Universes (PMU)

The majority of IB transfer credits are assigned a Breadth category. Refer to the [Faculty of Arts and Science Calendar](#) for more information.

Unspecified transfer credit: A course that has no exact equivalency in the Faculty. For example, CHM1**Y represents an unspecified first year credit in Chemistry. IB transfer credits are unspecified and may be used to meet prerequisite and/or program requirements as per the transfer credit chart.

Subjects not listed below may still be considered for transfer credit. The Faculty of Arts and Science reserves the right to change transfer credit policies without notice.
