



OSAP Academic Progress Form

Use this form if you have been placed on an OSAP Academic Probation. OSAP’s rules are different from U of T’s academic probation rules. When you receive OSAP funding you agree to remain enrolled in and pass a 60% course load for each term (40% for a student with a permanent disability).

You can be placed on OSAP probation if you drop below the required course load, or if you do not pass a sufficient number of credits. Multiple program switches, course drops, withdrawals, multiple repeats of a program and/or taking multiple programs may also be considered as unsatisfactory academic progress.

You can receive funding while on probation but you must write an explanation of your academic progress, and ensure that you meet OSAP’s minimum academic standards during your probation. Failure to meet the standards for two years in a row can lead to a loss of OSAP eligibility for a minimum of one year.
